Monday 22nd March to Thursday 1st April: Nominations can be sent to office.

Thursday 1st April 5pm: Close of nominations. Returning Officer sends email to those nominated informing them of any contested posts.

EASTER HOLIDAYS

Monday 19th April to 5pm Friday 23rd April: Candidates may withdraw nominations.

Friday 23rd April 5pm: Candidates notified by Returning Officer if an election is to be held. Candidates may write Election Statements if posts contested. **Deadline for statements 5pm Monday 26th April.**

Week beginning Monday 26th April: Ballot papers sent into schools.

Monday 3rd May to Friday 14th: Balloting takes place.

Friday 14th May: **Ballot closes 5pm.**

Monday 17th May: AGM. Declaration of Election results.
